# County Employees / Equipment—Work on private property.

(a) Private property work prohibited. In accordance with state law, county employees are prohibited from working on private property, except under the conditions noted in this policy.

(b)*Conditions allowing work on private property.* County employees may be permitted to work on private property under one or more of the following conditions:

(1) For law enforcement, building inspection, animal control and other such functions related to protecting the health and safety of Mitchell County citizens through the enforcement of federal, state, and local laws, and regulations.

(2) In the event of a locally declared natural or technological disaster or emergency on a case-by-case basis as determined by the Mitchell County Board of Commissioners.

(3) To fulfill a legitimate public interest associated with providing one or more the services authorized by the laws of the State of Georgia and on the case-by-case approval of the Mitchell County Board of Commissioners. Private property work of this type shall require a contract, easement, or other written agreement with the property owner acceptable to the County Attorney.

(4) In a situation to protect public infrastructure such as roads, bridges, or culverts, etc.

(5) Any other situation that, in the opinion of the County Attorney is permitted by Georgia law.

*Interpretation.* The Board of Commissioners reserves the right to interpret and apply this policy to the highest benefit of the public interest.

#### Process

In the event a situation exists that creates a hazard to public infrastructure, the following process must occur before county equipment or personnel can work on private property for one of the reasons listed above.

1) The County Administrator should be notified by the Mitchell County Department Head or citizen requesting a situation be evaluated.

- 2) The situation affecting the public infrastructure can be identified by either citizens or Mitchell County.
- 3) The situation must be studied by the Local Issuing Agency (LIA) and a certified engineer selected by Mitchell County.
- 4) If the situation is determined to be a hazard to the public infrastructure, the County Attorney must write a letter to the Mitchell County Board of Commissioners stating this activity is allowed by federal, state, and local laws and does no violate the Georgia Gratuities Clause.
- 5) If Mitchell County identifies the situation, Mitchell County will bear all expenses for Engineering and legal cost.
- 6) If a citizen requests a situation to be looked at and it is deemed a threat to the public infrastructure, Mitchell County will bear the expense for the engineer and legal cost.
- 7) If a citizen requests a situation to be looked at and it is not deemed a threat to the public infrastructure, the citizen will bear one-half of the expense for the engineer and legal cost with Mitchell County bear the other half of the expenses.
- 8) If a situation is identified as a threat to the public infrastructure as outlined above, a right of entry and a release of liability must be acquired from the property owner before any work can be performed.
- 9) This process can be bypassed if there is a situation where a catastrophic failure to the public infrastructure is imminent.
- 10) This does not affect any current prescriptive easement that may be in place.

## Use of Mitchell County Owned Properties Facility Use Guidelines

Mitchell County Board of Commissioners owns several facilities and properties that may be used by citizens of Mitchell County for certain types of events. It is the responsibility of the County Administrator to protect the public and the property when these facilities are used.

Only Mitchell County residents will be allowed to request the use of any of the county owned facilities and properties. All meetings, events, or gatherings at any Mitchell County owned property where public attendance is invited or solicited must be on a nondiscriminatory basis. All facilities must be available to all people without regard to sex, race, color, or national origin. Duplicate but equal events which maintain segregation on these bases will not be permitted.

If authorized to use any Mitchell County owned property, the requesting organization or person must use the facility for the designed use only. The requesting organization or person agrees the facility will be used and enjoyed at its sole risk and in consideration hereby releases, relinquishes, and discharges and agrees to indemnify, protect, and save harmless the County of Mitchell and any of its agencies, of and from any and all claims, demands or liabilities for any injury to, including the death of persons (whether they are third party persons or employees of either of the parties thereto), any loss or damage of property including injury or death of livestock or other animals (whether it is that of either or the parties hereto or third persons) caused by or growing out of or in any way happening in connection with its exercise of the privileges herein granted.

#### General Guidelines for all county owned facilities

- 1. No event will be allowed without obtaining written approval from the Mitchell County Administrator and completion of the Facility Use form apart from the Mitchell County Ag Center.
- 2. No event will be allowed at the Mitchell County Ag Center without obtaining a written approval from the Mitchell County Extension Office after completing the Facility Use form.
- 3. Mitchell County has the right to deny any application.
- 4. Any event sponsored by the Mitchell County Extension Service, or any Vocational Ag Department will take precedence over all other uses.
- 5. No alcohol will be permitted on any county owned property.

- 6. Noise from events must not violate the Mitchell County Noise Control Ordinance (sec. 30-56).
- 7. All facilities must be cleaned after the event ends and before the grounds are vacated.
- 8. Any damage to the facility, equipment, tables, chairs, or grounds will be the responsibility of the requestor to repair or replace at their cost.
- 9. No two events can be scheduled on the same day.
- 10. There will be no fires burning on any county properties, except for contained grills for food preparations.

### Courthouse Park specific additions to General Guidelines

- 1. All activities must end by 11:30 PM.
- 2. The Courthouse Park shall not be used for any event including dances or benefits where admission is charged.
- 3. When the Courthouse Park is booked for school related functions, the school principal or school superintendent will be required to sign a request form.
- 4. A \$ 100 damage deposit will be required for use of the Courthouse Park for private citizens, private organizers, private businesses, and For-Profit organizations.
- 5. There will be no damage deposit for governmental entities, non-profit organizations, and religious organizations.
- 6. Food vendors are allowed but must follow the Department of Public Health guidelines and protect the property from damage or spillage.
- 7. There will be no utility hook ups to the courthouse during any events.

### Mitchell County Ag Center and grounds to include the Horse Arena

- 1. USE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN ANY FORM IS PROHIBITED INSIDE OR ON THE GROUNDS OF THE AG-CENTER OR HORSE ARENA. It is the responsibility of the utilizer/using organization to enforce this policy. If alcohol is found during the event, the event will be closed, and no money refunded. If any evidence of use or consumption of alcohol is found upon inspection, the requester's deposit is automatically forfeited, and you will not be allowed to use the facilities again. VIOLATION OF ANY RULE WILL CAUSE A FORFIET OF THE DEPOSIT.
- 2. No smoking is allowed inside the Ag Center.
- 3. Food Service is not provided. The requestor is expected to make these arrangements with the concurrence of the Mitchell County Extension Coordinator.
- Events will not be scheduled back-to-back. A minimum of two (2) days must be allowed between events to provide proper time for cleaning and maintenance. Clean up by requestor must be completed by NOON the day after the event.
- 5. The Ag Center is not designed to hold livestock for an extended period. Therefore, animals will not be received more than two (2) days prior to show or sale and must be removed within one (1) day following the event. Livestock must be confined to the

immediate facility. Horses cannot be tied on sides or front of Ag-Center and must be kept in areas behind Ag-Center. The requestor is expected to furnish its own bedding, feed, water equipment, security and other special materials used in preparation of the facility for a livestock event.

- 6. Horse Arena users must provide portable potties for their events.
- 7. Charge for admission 'at the door' or prior sale of admission for said event is prohibited.
- 8. Mitchell County Extension, Ag Departments, Southwest Georgia Saddle Club, all schools in Mitchell County and other Mitchell County government functions that serve the people of the county can use the facilities at no charge.
- 9. Private organization/individual will be charged \$300.00 per day plus \$150.00 security deposit. The entire deposit is refundable if the facility is left clean, all rules are followed, and the event is over by 5:00 PM. If the event is not over by 5:00 PM, \$75.00 of security deposit will be used to acquire security for the events after 5:00 PM hours. The security deposit will not be returned if any rules are not followed.
- 10. For-Profit organizations/individuals will be charged \$400.00 per day plus \$150.00 security deposit. The entire deposit is refundable if the facility is left clean, all rules are followed, and the event is over by 5:00 PM. If the event is not over by 5:00 PM, \$75.00 of security deposit will be used to acquire security for the events after 5:00 PM. The security deposit will not be returned if any rules are not followed.
- 11. Agriculture related events will be charged \$100.00 per day plus \$100 security deposit which is refundable if all rules are followed, and the facility is left clean.
- 12. Occupancy cannot exceed the fire occupancy rating.
- 13. When approval has been confirmed by return of this executed Facility Use form, preparations for the event may be arranged by calling the Mitchell County Extension Coordinator at 229-336-2066.

#### Mitchell County Boat Ramps (Baconton, Hwy 37, and Vada)

- 1. No Overnight stays unless a permit is obtained from the Mitchell County Building and Zoning Office.
- 2. Any approved event may be cancelled at any time due to the river rising or projected to rise to unsafe levels.
- 3. Boat landings may be closed to the public during times of high-water levels.
- 4. All posted rules must be followed.

Below is a listing of the current state of affairs at the Recreation Department.

- 1. Spring Sports began with opening night on April 9<sup>th</sup>. Our games were rained out on April 11<sup>th</sup>.
  - a. 4U Tee-ball: 4 teams
  - b. 6U Coach Pitch: 6 teams
  - c. 8U Softball: 2 teams
  - d. 10U Softball: 2 teams
  - e. 8U Baseball: 3 teams
  - f. 10U Baseball: 2 teams
  - g. 12U Baseball: 2 teams
- 2. The weeks of April 15<sup>th</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> we will be playing in Camilla. The weeks of April 29<sup>th</sup>, May 6<sup>th</sup>, and May 13<sup>th</sup> we will be playing in Pelham.
- 3. We are playing the following Recreation Departments this year across all our leagues: Cairo-Grady County, Thomasville YMCA, Bainbridge-Decatur County, Miller County, and Albany Recreation.
- 4. Using CIP money we sent 14 kids to Cairo to the Team 24 Facility for pitching and catching lessons in our 12U Boys Division.

### Southwest Georgia Regional Commission Regional Council Meeting Camilla, Georgia March 28, 2024

The Southwest Georgia Regional Commission (RC) held its Council meeting Thursday, March 28, 2024, at the Camilla Depot in Camilla, Georgia. Chairman Anthony Jones chaired the meeting. The following council members were present: Denise Robinson, Eddie Hopkins, Charlie Williams, Benny Flowers, Paul Nagy, Ferrell Ruis, Steve Brock, Stephanie Daniels, Anthony Jones, Jon Howard, Raymond Breaux, Haryl Dabney, Charlie Sol, Al Hutchins, Jr., Freddie Speight, Jim Sellers, Joe Walden, Dwight Hickman, Cicily Florence, Jayme Smith, Ben Hayward, Danny Palmer, Alfred Brown, Brenda Peterson, Mitchell Blanks, Tori Gravlee, Ed Wade, Edward Ament, Donnie Baggett, Lucinda Brown, Jason Giddens, Elaine Mays, Christopher Wheeler, and Melvin Harris.

Chairman Jones called the meeting to order at approximately 7:02 p.m.

Executive Director Suzanne Angell gave the attendance report stating that there were 34 members present representing 14 counties and a quorum was present. Early County, Calhoun County, Mitchell County, Seminole County, Terrell County, and Thomas County had 100% representation. Ms. Angell then recognized the guests.

Chairman Jones asked for a motion that the February 2024 meeting minutes to be approved. Elaine Mays motioned the minutes be accepted and Al Hutchins, Jr. seconded the motion; all agreed.

Chairman Jones invited Nominating Committee Chairman Paul Nagy to give his committee report. Mr. Nagy asked for a motion to accept the slate as officers as presented at the last meeting as they have been tabled for 30 days. Elaine Mays made the motion to accept the slate of 2024 Executive Committee members/officers. Raymond Breau seconded the motion; all agreed. The 2024 SWGRC Officers and Executive Committee are as follows: Anthony Jones, Chairman, Donnie Baggett, Vice-Chairman, Al Hutchins, Jr., Treasurer, and members, Danny Palmer, Brenda Peterson, Benny Flowers, Joe Walden, and Dwight Hickman.

Chairman Jones invited Deputy Director Barbara Reddick to present her Planning Report to the Council. Mrs. Reddick proceeded to give her report to the Council.

Chairman Jones invited Director of Finance Traci Hall to present her financial report for the period ending February 29, 2024, for the Council's approval. Mrs. Hall presented the financial report and Chairman Jones asked for a motion to accept the February 2024 financial report, as presented. Elaine Mays made a motion to accept the February 2024 financial report. Dwight Hickman seconded the motion; all agreed.

Mrs. Angell proceeded to give the Executive Director's report. She began by discussing the Council Member Training that happened just prior to the meeting. Next, Mrs. Angell let the Council know that she and Mrs. Reddick, along with the AARP State Director of Community Outreach, Kay Sibetta were interviewed March 21<sup>st</sup> to discuss the Age Friendly Program and how that program impacts Southwest Georgia. Mrs. Angell said she has been in contact with DHS, along with several other RC Executive Directors to express concerns over The State of Georgia soliciting human service transportation services for the entire state of Georgia. The SWGRC Ford 500s have both been sold by sealed bid. We received approximately thirty bids. We received bids from two vendors for three new vehicles and they have been ordered. Mrs. Angell mentioned that we are waiting for a draft lease agreement for review from our attorney for the Regional Commission building. Mayor Owens and she discussed rent for the office space at \$1 a year and a provision for any single repair over \$10,000 to be paid for by the city. We have three counties (Baker, Colquitt, and Miller) participating in the P25 regional system. We have recently received proposals for two GA AIM projects. Mrs. Angell mentioned, although there have been technical issues, there is now one central number for transit riders to call when arranging to get a ride. The next City/County Managers meeting will be held on May 15<sup>th</sup> in Camilla. A representative from HUD has been asked to give a presentation at this meeting. We are waiting for a response. Two of our employees will be representing SWGRC as a vendor at a job fair in Terrell County on March 29<sup>th</sup>. The proposals for retirement services from ACCG and GMA are due March 30<sup>th</sup>. We will have another Retirement Trustees' meeting in April to review and approve proposals. Mrs. Angell mentioned that she and Traci Hall expect to have the FY24 Budget Amendment completed to present at the April 2024 meeting. Mrs. Angell said that she was requested by GMA and the City of Blakely to serve on an interview panel for the City of Blakely to assist in selecting a qualified candidate for their Fire Chief position. Kay Olubowale and Mrs. Angell will be serving on a Project Advisory Council for the City of Albany's twenty-year master plan update for the SWGA Regional Airport. It is a sixteen-month process.

Chairman Jones stated if there was no other business, the next meeting will be April 25, 2024. The meeting was adjourned at approximately 7:30 p.m.
